AND IN CASE YOU WERE WONDERING.....THE HELMET LAW BILL HAS BEEN RE-INTRODUCED. It is HB 2656. It is currently with the House Transportation Committee, and will also be handled by the Joint Ways and Means Sub-Committee Number Six, whose Members are listed above. You should write to the individual Ways and Means Committee Members, and ALSO the members of the House Transportation Committee, listed below. Use the same address as the samples given above, except that the House Members are addressed as "Representative".

Write to these people and ask for a "NO" vote on HB 2656. It is the Mandatory Helmet Law all over again!

REMEMBER: THESE PEOPLE CLAIM TO BE WORKING FOR THE PEOPLE. SO, PEOPLE, TELL THEM WHAT YOU WANT THEM TO DO.

- AGAIN: DO spell the person's name correctly
- DO ask for a specific vote on a specific Bill
- DO write to each individual Member
- DO NOT use threats
- DO NOT use "objectionable language"

A simple statement requesting a yes or no vote on a specific Bill is a good letter. You can add your opinion, as an adult Motorcycle Rider, but the most important thing is to WRITE THE LETTERS. Fancy words don't count for much. Lots of letters DO COUNT. ABATE is not doing this for you, and you are not doing this for ABATE, you are doing this for YOURSELF, so BE SELFISH and WRITE TO YOUR ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES and tell them how you would like them to vote, since YOU can't vote on the Bill yourself.
