
I am sure that the Chapters in Non-compliance will take care of this matter before the next State Board meeting.

* GUIDELINES FOR FLIERS *

As winter approaches once again, I felt it would be useful to re-run this article. I hope those of you responsible for drawing up your chapter's run fliers will follow the guidelines below - they apply to the fliers you hand out as well as those that appear in the newsletter:

- 1) Try to make your message as brief and to the point as possible. Many fliers are thrown away unread because they look too "busy". Keep in mind that I generally reduce fliers to 1/4 size, which has the effect of "cramming" things together. Give a phone number to call for more information, rather than trying to cram everything in.
- 2) Vertical format, rather than horizontal, is **preferred**.
- 3) Allow at least 1/4" of blank paper on all four sides of the page.
- 4) Maps are great on the back of the hand-out fliers, but when you include a map for the newsletter, please do so on a separate sheet of paper. It's easier for me to copy and reduce them if I don't have to worry about something on the back side of the "master" showing thru in the "copy".
- 5) Please send me copys that are as close to the original as possible; i.e. the "first generation" copy. A copy of a copy of a copy can look awfully bad by the time the newsletter gets printed. Whoever is responsible for drawing up the original flier should send me the very first copy made, and USE WHITE PAPER FOR THE NEWSLETTER COPY! I can't emphasize this point too much!! Colored paper "originals" do funny things in the photocopier - so use white paper (for me) only!!
- 6) Avoid using "banner" style headlines that consist of white letters surrounded by a black background - they reproduce and reduce poorly & require extra work to "clean-up" for printing.
- 7) There is NO ADMISSION CHARGED at any run sanctioned by ABATE of Oregon! Surprised? We are a "non-profit" organization, therefore, we can only ask for "donations". Please make sure your fliers use the word "DONATION". Also, please refrain from using the word "beer". Substitute "BEVERAGES".
- 8) Please try to have flyers to the Newsletter at least 60 days in advance of your run date. This is your Newsletter - take advantage of it in order to reach as many people as possible.

I hope this will be of some help to you when it comes time for you to prepare the flier for your run. I also want you to know that I don't mean you shouldn't use colored paper for the fliers you hand out at meetings - it's just that I need white paper to make copies from. If you make up a flier and ask members to make copies, make sure THEY get their "master" copy on white paper as well. Thanks!
