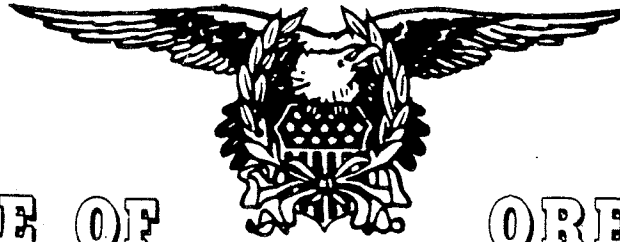

Brothers and Sisters,

Election time is almost upon us. How many of the same people are we going to re-elect that say they are for freedom of choice, but in actuality are not? Motorcyclist hurt after hitting Ali's car

West Hollywood, Calif.
(AP)—Former boxer Muhammad Ali was involved in an accident that left a motorcyclist slightly injured after Ali's Rolls Royce cut across traffic to make a left turn, authorities said today.

The motorcyclist, Gregory Gray, 26, complained of bruises and pain in his leg after the Tuesday night accident, said sheriff's Sgt. Guy Earl. Gray was treated at Cedars Sinai Medical

Center and released, said spokesman Ron Wise.

The former world heavyweight champion, driving a Rolls Royce at 5 mph to 15 mph, turned left from the right lane, Earl said. Gray, overtaking Ali in the left lane, hit the rear of Ali's car, he said.

"He (Ali) just cut across the left-hand lane" Earl said.

Ali, 44, was not cited pending an investigation, said Deputy Dave Hogan.

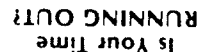
