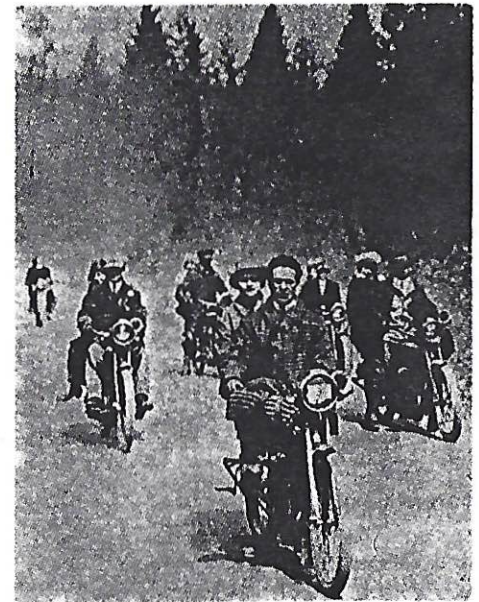

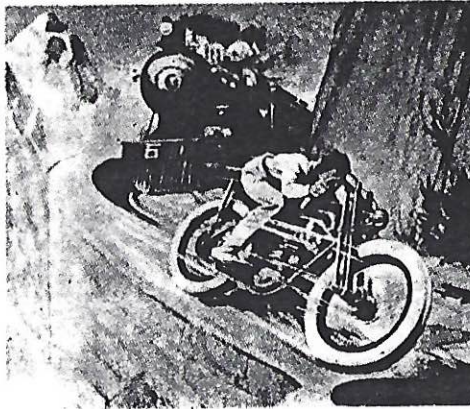

ABATE is a legislative action organization and has been instrumental in effecting fair laws concerning motorcycles.

ABATE is a registered State of Oregon non-profit organization. Members are active in their communities donating time and materials to the Shriners Hospital, senior citizens, Scouting, Red Cross, etc.

ABATE is a statewide organization with local chapters. Each chapter conducts business according to its own needs, under guidelines established by the state board. The elected state board is made up of two representatives from each chapter. The officers of the board are elected from these representatives. The state board meets monthly. State board and chapter meetings are open to the general membership and the public.
