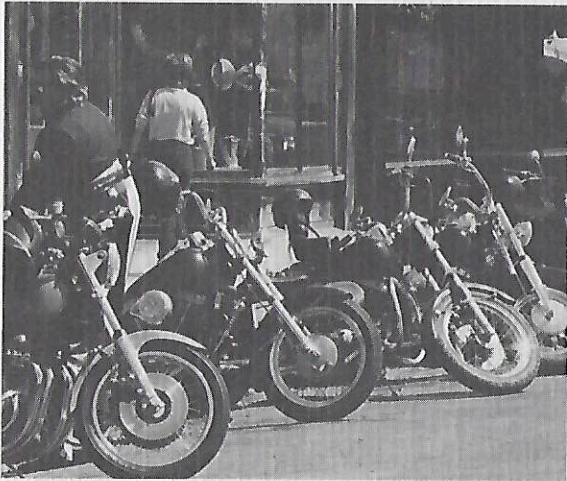

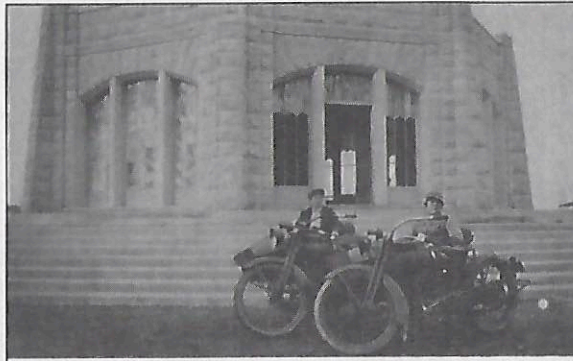

**ABATE** is motorcycle enthusiasts from all walks of life that have come together to work for sensible legislation, to voice the need for safe freedom of our public roads, and to foster and promote motorcycle awareness to the general public. We want everyone to know that we are doing all we can to make motorcycling safer for all.

**ABATE** is a legislative action organization and has been instrumental in effecting fair laws concerning motorcycles.

**ABATE** is a registered State of Oregon non-profit organization. Members are active in their communities donating time and materials to the Shriners Hospital, senior citizens, Scouting, Red Cross, etc.

**ABATE** is a statewide organization with local chapters. Each chapter conducts business according to its own needs, under guidelines established by the state board. The elected state board is made up of two representatives from each chapter. The officers of the board are elected from the general membership. The state board meets monthly. State board and chapter meetings are open to the general membership and the public.



**ABATE** was instrumental in forming TEAM Oregon to promote quality rider education programs for motorcyclists and public information programs for the public. ABATE organized and ran the first mobile better biking program, now offered by TEAM Oregon. TEAM Oregon courses are scheduled at community colleges and through the mobile program.
